In response, Governor Brewer and state leaders have slashed spending by record amounts – more than \$2.2 billion in all. Still, Arizona cannot make ends meet. Without more revenue, the state will need to cut another \$1 billion immediately.

If that happens, K-12 schools will lose yet another \$420 million. Higher education, another \$100 million. Public safety will suffer an \$85 million hit, while health and human services will lose another \$110 million.

Cuts like these will hurt our quality of life, hurt our student's chances of success and slow Arizona's economic recovery.

The solution? Proposition 100.

Proposition 100 is a temporary sales tax that expires in three years, per the state Constitution. A “yes” vote on 100 will raise \$1 billion a year, money directed by law to schools, public safety and health care.

While no one loves a tax increase, Proposition 100 is the responsible solution for Arizona. It's a difficult choice, but the right choice – a temporary revenue solution that will help us compete moving forward and protect the frayed safety net so many Arizonans need in tough times.
